ACT MASTERS HOCKEY SPORTING ACCIDENT POLICY

As an integral part of membership of ACT Masters Hockey its members are provided with some sporting accident insurance cover relating to on field injury, which is with SportsCover. The insurance with SportsCover can only be considered as basic and at entry level, and players, coaches, managers and other officials are urged to take out private health insurance.

To be eligible for insurance coverage it is mandatory that intending Masters players, coaches, managers and other officials complete and lodge the ACT Masters Association's membership application as well as the Hockey Australia membership application and have paid the relevant fees, where applicable, prior to their involvement in Masters Hockey. For continued insurance coverage players, coaches, managers and other officials must renew both memberships annually and pay the respective renewal fees, where applicable.

Should an injury be sustained it is important that the circumstances that led to the injury be advised to SportsCover as soon as practicable, including the date, time and place of the injury.
